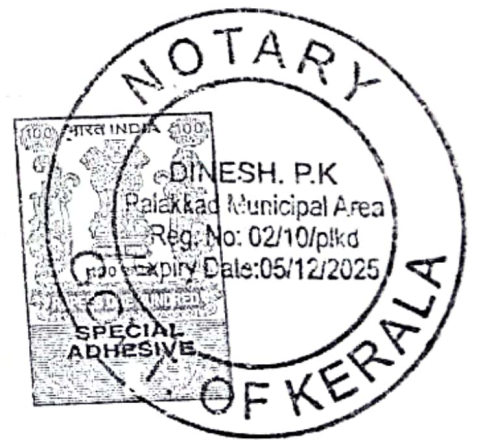

The Petitioner most respectfully submits as follows

1. World Wide Iron & Steels (P) Ltd is an iron steel company engaged in the manufacture of Iron & Steel.. The company has its Registered Office at VIII/862 and its factory at Kanjikode, Palakkad Kerala. The factory started its operations in 2003 and employs 20 managerial staff and 20 workmen directly and 75 workmen are engaged indirectly.
2. The petition is submitted as per 179 (2) of Supply Code, 2014 for seeking interpretation of Regulation 12 of Supply Code, 2014
3. Electricity plays a vital role in the operation of the plant. The supply is at 22 kV and the factory has a Contract Demand of 2990 kVA. The operations of the plant during the last two years was on a low key due to adverse market conditions created by Covid 19. As market conditions started showing revival, we decided modernization and expansion in our plant. To meet the additional power requirement, an application for additional power allocation of 1000 Kva.
4. In the reply of Dy Chief Engr, KSEBL dt25-2-2022, it is stated that “ --- it is stated in the Supply Code 2014 Reg 12, to a power intensive unit having a Contract Demand of more than 50% of the maximum contract demand for the specified voltage level (Here it is 22 kV maximum contract demand 6000 kVA) under reg 8 shall be granted through a dedicated feeder and the intending consumer shall meet the expenditure for the construction of the feeder.
5. Reg 12 of the Supply Code is extracted below
“12. Dedicated feeder to be provided to power intensive unit at its cost.- Service connection to power intensive unit shall be granted only through a dedicated feeder and the intending consumer shall meet the expenditure for construction of the feeder and related works including the necessary modification to the distribution system to be done by the licensee for this purpose, at the rates in the cost data approved by the Commission.”

6. From a plain reading of the Regulation, it is clear that the Regulation is applicable to new power intensive units only. It is admitted that, as per the Supply Code 2014, the factory belongs to power intensive category. But the factory was in operation for the last 19 years. It is meaningless to refer the Regulation in connection with additional power allocation for an existing unit. Further, the condition of '*more than 50% of the maximum contract demand for the specified voltage level ----*' stated in the letter is not there in the Regulation
7. The request is for an additional power allocation of 1000 kVA only which is less than 33% of the existing Contract Demand. Moreover, the total requirement of 3990 kVA is much less than the upper limit of 6000 kVA for 22 kVA consumers.
8. The factory is 19 years old and hence modernization has become a necessity for trouble free operation of the plant. It will be possible only if the power allocation is sanctioned. The additional expenditure required for a dedicated feeder will make the project unviable. It would also delay the project.
9. Prayer:In the above circumstances, we request the Hon'ble Commission to clarify that Regulation 12 of Kerala Electricity Supply Code, 2014 is not applicable to power intensive units already in operation and direct the respondent to allocate power as sought for by the petitioner.
